

The Summer Internship Programme of the Art Museum FAQ

1. Is it necessary to engage in this programme for 2 months?
The duration of this internship programme is 8 weeks. For more information, please refer to our posters.
2. Does the Programme only accept applications from CUHK students?
We welcome undergraduate/ post-graduate students from CUHK and other universities to apply for this internship.
3. Does Art Museum accept applications from non-local university students?
Yes. We accept applications from local and non-local university students.
4. Are there any specific requirements on the length and language of application letter?
There are no specific requirements on the length of application letter. We accept Chinese or English letters.
5. What are the language requirements of this programme?
Candidates with good Chinese and English language skills are desirable. Having basic knowledge of Cantonese is preferable.
6. I would like to know the number of vacancies of this programme.
There is no quota for admission of interns in this programme. We will offer Internship depending on actual needs.
7. Can Art Museum Ambassadors apply for Internship?
Yes. Art Museum Ambassadors can apply for this programme.
8. Will there be interviews for candidates?
Yes. Interviews will be conducted for shortlisted candidates.
9. Are there any skills requirements?
We welcome students with different skill sets to apply for this programme. Taking into account his/her strength, interest and the needs of the Art Museum, the selected candidate will be assigned to a team and assist in a current project of the team. Generally speaking, a candidate with knowledge in arts or strong interest in working in a museum is preferable.

10. I am interested in the Summer Internship Program, however, there is a 2-week field trip to the Mainland in mid- July. Is it possible for me to ask for a leave during that period if I am selected for the program?

The duration of our internship programme is 8 weeks but the starting date is relatively flexible, depending on the requirement of the projects that the Art Museum will carry out in this summer. The successful candidate should arrange with his/ her supervisor for leave matters.

11. Will the applicants receive notification of the result?

Only shortlisted candidates will be informed and invited to attend interview. Candidates who do not receive notifications within 2 months after the application deadline may assume their applications unsuccessful. No individual notifications will be sent to unsuccessful applicants.
